

## **NEWPORT CITY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES**

7:01 p.m. Clark Curtis called the meeting to order.

7:02 Clark Curtis introduced Mayor Paul Monette so that he could present a placque to outgoing Planning Commission and Historical Preservation Commission member Charles Elliott for 25 plus years of dedication and service to those two commissions.

7:04 p.m. minutes for the November 22nd, 2016 meeting were presented with Robert Currier moving to approve the minutes. Dan Ross seconded the motion. APPROVED BY UNANIMOUS DECISION.

7:06 P.M. KAREN GERAGHTY from NVDA did a presentation to the council on the NEWPORT RENAISSANCE. Her presentation explained a little about what the NR is, a map to show where it is in the City, and some of the benifits of haveing a Downtown Renaissance district. Some of the benifits include benifits of directing growth, 10% tax credit, 25% facade tax credit, 50% code implementation tax credit, Preservation Trust 10,000 grant for Beautification, and a walking path behind Vista. In the years since the Committee was established we have seen \$600,000 in tax credits and \$8,233,386 in private investments. The Renaissance designation is for 5 years and is up in November of 2017.
