Distinct from public hearings or town meetings, City Council meetings are held in public, but are not meetings of the public. City Council meetings are the only time the City Council members have to discuss, deliberate and decide upon City matters. In an effort to conduct orderly and efficient meetings, the Mayor kindly requests your cooperation and compliance with the following guidelines:

- 1. Please be respectful of each other, Council members, city staff, and the public.
- 2. Please raise your hand to be recognized by the Mayor. Once recognized, please state your name and address or affiliation.
- 3. Please address only the Mayor and not members of the public, staff, or presenters.
- 4. Please abide by any time limits. Time limits will be used to ensure everyone is heard and that there is sufficient time for the Council to complete their agenda within a reasonable timeframe.
- 5. The Mayor will make a reasonable effort to allow everyone to speak once before speakers address the Council a second time per the limited 2 minute timeline adopted on January 23, 2017.
- 6. Once public comment has been heard, discussion will be limited to the City Council members.
- 7. Please do not interrupt or mock other speakers or otherwise exhibit disruptive behavior during the City Council meeting.
- 8. Please do not repeat the points made by others, except to indicate agreement or disagreement with other views.
- 9. Please use the hallway for side conversations. It is difficult to hear speaker remarks when side conversations are occurring in the Council Chamber.
- 10. Presentations to the Council are not open to public comment. However, per the policy adopted on December 21, 2015, matters on the agenda requiring a vote are open to public comment immediately prior to the Council vote.
- 11. Individuals who do not abide by these procedures will be asked to leave the Council Chamber.

#### August 5, 2024

A duly warned meeting of the Newport City council was held on Monday, August 5, 21024 in the council room in the Newport Municipal Building. Present were Mayor Linda Sullivan, Council President Chris Vachon, Council Members Kevin Charboneau, Rick Ufford-Chase, Clark Curtis, City Manager Jonathan DeLaBruere, City Clerk/Treasurer James Johnson, Frank Cheney Jr. Tom Bernier, Members of the Press and Public.

Mayor Sullivan called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

#### Additions/Deletions to the Agenda

Item number 4 changed to Tax abatement/stabilization, number 6 Tabled, and number 12 deleted.

# **Consent Agenda**

Mr. Curtis moved to approve the consent agenda including a new vendor permit request. Seconded by Mr. Vachon, motion carried.

#### **Tax Stabilization- NEKDC**

The council and Mr. Cheney discussed the 2022 Stabilization request. The council agreed to the stabilization policy but a motion was never passed granting the stabilization. This may not be a valid reason to abate taxes. NEKDC should reapply for tax stabilization. Mr. Cheney will contact NEKDC.

# FY 2023-2024 Single Audit Engagement Letter

# **DPW In-Kind Grant timeline Update**

Mr. DeLaBruere stated that DPW is committed to two remaining projects. The Gardner Park Remediation and the Causeway lighting Project. The Gardner Park Project is nearing completion and the Causeway project will hopefully be completed in the spring.

# **Authorization to Have Council Conduct a Tax Sale**

Mr. Ufford-Chase authorized the City Attorney to move forward with the tax sale process. Seconded by Mr. Vachon, motion carried.

# USDA Community Facilities Grant Public Meeting for FY 24 RADIOS AND Water Rescue Equipment

The council held a Public Hearing on the USDA Community Facilities Grant Application. Mr. DeLaBruere explained the Grant Process and Requirements. This is a \$56,000 grant. \$19,600 will be grant funds and \$36,400 will come from City funds. The grant is for Fire Department 10 Radios, 10 Pagers and Water Rescue Equipment. Ms. Chiarello asked if they were absolutely needed. Mr. DeLaBruere noted that the Radios and pagers are older models and there is no water rescue equipment.

#### POLICY ON ADMINISTRATION OF PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS

PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY. This Policy applies to all public records requests made to the City of Newport (the "City")-City Council and its members under the Vermont Public Record Act, 1 V.S.A. §310-320 (the "Act") except for requests for public records maintained by an elected City official that is not a City Council member. The Newport City Council is authorized under the Act to adopt reasonable rules to prevent disruption of operations in responding to records requests, preserve the security of public records, and protect public records from damage. This Policy is intended to provide timely and coordinated responses to such records requests.

**REQUESTS FOR RECORDS.** All requests to inspect or copy public records in the charge or custody of the Newport City Council, or its members, appointed officers, or staff shall be made to the City Manager. The City Manager shall promptly inform the City Council of public records requests and work with the City Council members and City personnel to compile and produce the requested documents in accordance with the requirements of the Act. For the purpose of responding to such requests, the City Manager shall be considered the custodian of the records as that term is used in Section 318 of the Act.

**CONFIRMATION OF SEARCH.** City personnel, including appointed City officers, City department heads, City Council members, and City staff, shall search for public records responsive to a Public Records Act request upon the request of the City Manager. For Public Records Act requests that require searches of email, text messages, and/or correspondence, City personnel shall search their City email, private email, text messages, and correspondence for public records potentially responsive to the Public Records Act Request, then provide the City Manager any public records potentially responsive to the request that they find along with a written statement (which may be an email) providing the following information:

- What the individual did to search for responsive public records, including what files/accounts the individual searched, and what keyword searches the individual performed:
- 2. That the individual has identified all public records potentially responsive to the request in their files/accounts and provided them to the City Manager; and
- 3. The amount of time the individual spent searching for and compiling public records potentially responsive to the request.<sup>1</sup>

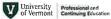
**PRODUCTION OF RECORDS.** Upon production of the records to the requestor, the City Manager shall provide a copy of the records produced to the City Council members.

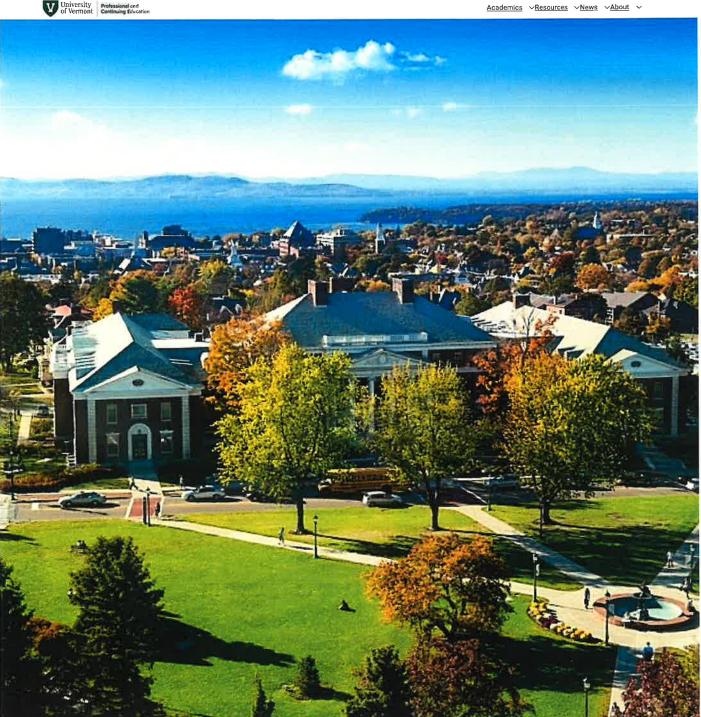
**CITY MANAGER'S ABSENCE.** When the City Manager is absent or otherwise unavailable to respond to a request within the Act's deadlines, the Program Manager/Comptroller shall respond to the request, shall be considered the custodian of the records for the purpose of the response, and shall comply with the requirements of this Policy.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> This statement/affirmation is meant to ensure compliance with Vermont Supreme Court caselaw which requires the City to "conduct a good faith reasonable search of those systems of records likely to possess the requested records" when responding to Public Records Act requests. *Toensing v. Attorney General*, 2017 VT 99, ¶ 27, 206 Vt. 1, 178 A.3d 1000 (internal citations omitted).

**APPEAL PROCESS.** If the requestor is unsatisfied with the production of records received, a request should be submitted in writing to the Mayor or the Council President in the Mayor's absence.
